CESCY (Circular Economy - Sustainable Competencies for Youth) project is an Erasmus+ funded Strategic Partnership 2019-2022 between partners from six countries. The aim of the project is to **connect youth work and youth to circular economy and sustainability.**

In the frame of the project, we have designed a competence framework for youth for circular economy and a toolkit for youth workers and educational practitioners to support youth in their learning in the circular economy and sustainability areas.

CESCY competence framework for circular economy and sustainability describes a set of knowledge, skills and attitudes to promote in youth work for youth to lead the circular economy transition.

Aim of the training:

The aim of this training is to engage youth workers in the circular economy field through the competence framework we have developed and train them on how to use it in their daily work with youth.

During this event we would like to:

- Reflect on the role of youth workers in the circular economy.
- Train youth workers on how to support young people regarding the circular economy and its needed competencies.
- Learn, feedback and share non formal learning approaches and methods to implement the circular economy competencies framework in youth work.
- Create a network of youth workers addressing the circular economy and sustainability transition through youth work and non formal education.







The training is organised in cooperation with organisations from Belgium, Estonia, Italy, Spain, Netherlands and Portugal.

Profile of participants:

- Youth workers, youth leaders, social workers
- Good English level, both spoken and written
- At least 18 years old
- With at least 2 years of working or volunteering experiences with young people
- Working on a daily basis with youth
- With an understanding of non-formal education methodologies
- Have knowledge and experience in designing and delivering learning experiences.
- With an interest in circular economy, climate change, sustainability, environmental issues.

Date and place of the seminar:

The training is held in Almuñécar (Andalucia), Spain from 15th to 20th of May 2022, where 15th is the arrival day and 20th is the departure day.

The working days will be from 16th to 19th of May 2022.

Erasmus+ contribution to the project:

The costs for accommodation and food will be covered for all participants. All the materials necessary to the realisation of the seminar will be provided by the organisers.

The travel reimbursement is reimbursed up to a predefined amount depending on your departure country:

- Spain up to 180€
- Portugal, Belgium, Netherlands, Italy up to 275€
- Estonia up to 360€
