

## Flash Eurobarometer 523 Integration of young people into the labour market with particular focus on traineeships

A traineeship is a short work experience, either paid or unpaid, that includes learning and training. It is typically done by young people before starting regular jobs.

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**19%** of young people's first work experience was a traineeship






Furthermore, the 2013 averages include the UK and exclude Croatia. Due to rounding, some totals may not correspond with the sum of the separate figures.
